### **Wilderness First Aid (Ages 14+)**

**July 15-16 8am-5pm**

This 16+ hour course expands general first aid to give more detailed information and hands-on skills practice for the remote setting – using what you will find in your backpack to care for patients. The ESCI Wilderness First Aid class covers assessment and urgent first aid techniques. This is an excellent course for Scout troops or any outdoors group studying survival skills.

Cost: \$145/student

### **Alice's Adventures (Ages 13+)**

**July 25th-27th, 2-4pm**

Spend a few days exploring Alice in Wonderland, as well as life in the reversed world on the other side of Alice's Looking Glass-- both stories by Lewis Carroll, famous English writer, mathematician, photographer, college dean and Anglican deacon. Learn math and language magic while playing the games each story describes. Discover the symbols and subtle game strategies hidden in plain view, while learning about these timeless, fun classics about self-discovery, identity, and personal perception.

Cost: \$95/student

### **What's in a Law? (Ages 13+)**

**June 26th, 2-6pm**

An introduction to what you can't learn from action and crime dramas, including: civil and UNCivil (criminal!) law; how laws are made and changed, how torts (and they're not pastries!) and courts collide... plus answers to questions you've always wondered about.

Cost: \$40/student

### **Career Readiness**

**June 3rd, 10am-2pm**

A one-day course for Juniors and Seniors in beginning work skills: learn how to build your resume and describe your skills; get tips for job interviews; and "try out" different professional styles and tasks. Role playing, exercises, videos and stories galore!

Cost: \$40/student

### **Introduction to Calculus (HS-College)**

**August 28th-31st, 12-2pm**

This one-week intensive is intended for students who are starting the first term of calculus fall of 2017. We will review the most important parts of pre-calculus, including rational functions, working with polynomials, and limits. We will then break into the first "big idea" in calculus, that of the derivative, in preparation for fall. This is a fast-paced, fun curriculum suitable for high school or college students.

Cost: \$125/student

### **SAT/ACT for the Summer: Dates Vary**

The SAT offers a summer test date, August 26th, and ACT offers September 9th. Oregon Tutor's SAT & ACT courses are both highly reviewed, and offer 20 hours of instruction along with take-home work to reinforce skills.
